





Kroger Handled Recalls


- In 2008, Kroger handled over 330 recalls and Product Withdrawals.
 - Class I 88
 - Class II 106
 - Class III 23
 - Product Withdrawals 122
- In 2009, we have handled over 70 Class I Recalls already.

















Class I Recall Notice For: Detour Strength Bars



Due to the severity of this recall, we have put in place a restriction of sale code on the below listed UPC's. This restriction will prevent the sale of this

item, but should not prevent their return - providing they are handled as a void. This restriction code has been automatically applied as of 6:10 EST, today.

The first priority is to remove all of the below listed items from the sales floor and handle the disposition according to the recall notice instructions. Note: The recalls are for a specific code, but all product should be pulled. The product with the included code(s) should be handled as instructed in the recall notice.

Product outside of the code lot should be held until further notice.


